

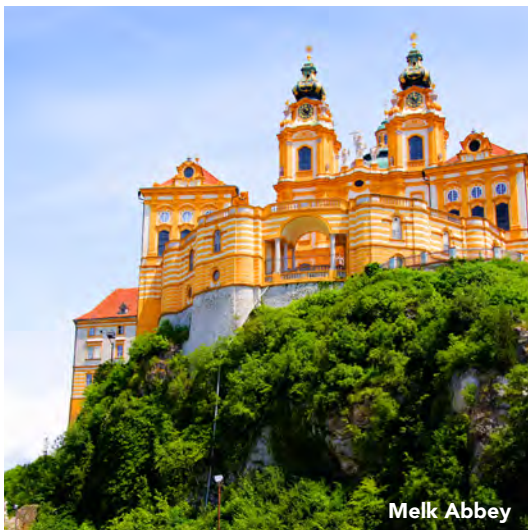

Day 1: En Route from U.S.

Day 2: Munich / Passau – Embarkation (D)
Transfer to Passau, board *Amadeus Riva*, join group for special welcome cocktail and dinner
Overnight: *Amadeus Riva*

Day 3: Regensburg / Weltenburg (B,L,D)
See architecture of Regensburg, board excursion boat for transport to Weltenburg Abbey for a tour and beer tasting
Overnight: *Amadeus Riva*

Day 4: Passau / Linz (B,L,D)
Guided walking tours of Passau and Linz plus a bakery visit and torte tasting
Overnight: *Amadeus Riva*

Day 5: Emmersdorf / Dürnstein / Vienna (B,L,D)
Visit to Melk Abbey and vineyard tour, plus wine tasting in the Wachau Valley
Overnight: *Amadeus Riva*

Day 6: Vienna (B,L,D)

Guided panoramic city tour of Vienna plus inside visit to Schönbrunn Palace; optional evening event—intimate live classical music performance
Overnight: *Amadeus Riva*

Day 7: Bratislava (B,L,D)

Guided city tour with optional old town walking tour; afternoon excursion to Schloss Hof Palace and Estate
Overnight: *Amadeus Riva*

Day 8: Esztergom / Budapest (B,L,D)

Guided panoramic city touring, special evening entertainment on board
Overnight: *Amadeus Riva*

Day 9: Budapest – Disembarkation / Depart for U.S. (B)

(B = Breakfast, L = Lunch, D = Dinner)

Activity Level: Activities are generally not very strenuous. A fair amount of walking can be expected. Wear comfortable walking shoes. Guests can expect to follow a guide through cobblestone streets at an average pace for two hours, and walk up and down stairs without assistance. Historic city centers are usually more accessible by foot. At times, it may be not possible for your motor coach to drop you off at hotel and site entrances. Due to the structure of some buildings, handrails may not be present, and facilities for the disabled may be limited.

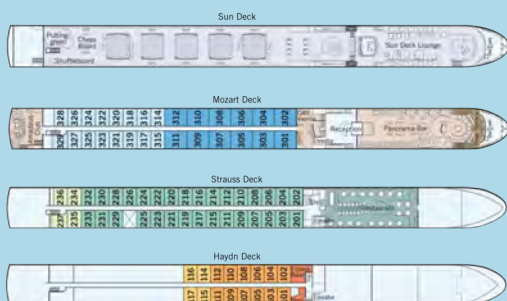

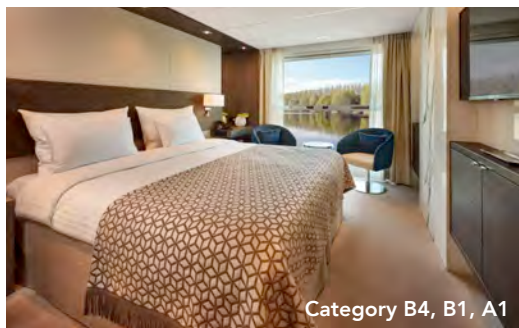
