Overnight: Grande Denali Lodge
- Day 3:** Denali National Park
Wilderness Excursion (B,L)
Guided backcountry adventure, evening at leisure
Overnight: Grande Denali Lodge
- Day 4:** Denali National Park (B,R)
Optional excursions or activities such as self-guided hikes and ranger-led talks; wine and hors d'oeuvres with an Alaskan homesteader
Overnight: Grande Denali Lodge
- Day 5:** Denali National Park / Anchorage (B,L,D)
Travel on the flagship train, the *Denali Star*, through one of the most scenic stretches of the world-famous Alaska Railroad
Overnight: Hotel Captain Cook
- Day 6:** Depart Anchorage (B)

Optional Excursions:

DogGonelt Dog Sled Tour: An intimate visit to an Alaskan frontier home to learn about the lives of the world's greatest athletes, sled dogs, and racing the Iditarod.

Denali Glacier Landing Flight: A 100-minute plane tour of Denali, viewing the continent's deepest gorge, glaciers, surrounding peaks and valleys and a landing on one of Denali's pristine glaciers.

Arctic Circle Flight Tour: This 6.5 hours tour includes a flight crossing into the Arctic Circle, ground tour of the only year-round village in the area, and visit to Coldfoot Camp.

- Familiarize yourself with Denali National Park, walking its trails with naturalists.
