





Activity Level: This program requires an ability to walk over uneven, sometimes slippery ground, and get in and out of a 4 X 4 Land Cruiser. Average elevation: 5,000 feet










Accommodations are subject to change. While specific properties are secured well in advance, it is sometimes necessary to substitute hotels and camps with as-good or better options.

What's Included

- Accommodations at Kigali Serena Hotel and Mountain Gorilla View Lodge (or similar)
- 3 breakfasts, 2 lunches, and 2 dinners
- Excursion transportation, all park fees, and one gorilla trek permit

Activity Level: Guests should be in very good physical condition with the ability to walk up and down hills in tropical forests on uneven, sometimes rocky, steep and/or slippery, terrain. The forest can be humid and paths may have heavy vegetation.








Your Expedition Leader:

What's Included

- Internal airfare from Arusha to Zanzibar

- 2 breakfasts, 2 lunches, and 2 dinners
- Guided panoramic walking city tour
- Admission to the House of Wonders, the Palace Museum, and Jozani Chwaka Bay National Park
- All excursion transportation
- Airport transfer for guests departing at the suggested times

Activity Level: Activities are generally not very strenuous, but a fair amount of walking can be expected. It is our expectation that guests are able to follow a guide through cobblestone streets, and even and uneven terrain, at an average pace for two hours, and walk up and down stairs without assistance.



Reservation Grace Period. Reservations for the main tour and post-tour made 121+ days prior to the departure date may be cancelled within 30 days of the reservation date ("Grace Period") for a full refund. Notice of cancellation must be received in writing during the Grace Period. The date of receipt will be used for the effective date.

Reservation Cancellations and Refunds. Notice of cancellation must be submitted to Orbridge in writing. The date of receipt will be used for the effective date. All payments made for the pre-tour are non-refundable. If the cancellation notice is received after the Grace Period (if applicable): (a) 91+ days prior to the departure date, all monies paid for the main tour and post-tour will be refunded less an administrative fee of \$350 per person for the main program and \$200 per person for a post-tour; (b) 90-76 days prior to the departure date, a 25% cancellation fee will be applied to the full cost of the main tour and post-tour and the balance will be refunded; (c) 75-61 days prior to the departure date, a 50% cancellation fee will be applied to the full cost of the main tour and post-tour and the balance will be refunded; (d) 60-46 days prior to the departure date, a 75% cancellation fee will be applied to the full cost of the main tour and post-tour and the balance will be refunded; (e) within 45 days prior to the departure date, a 100% cancellation fee will be applied to the full program cost. A 100% cancellation fee applies to all non-refundable airfare. Refunds, if any, will be processed within 30 days of our receipt of your written notice.
